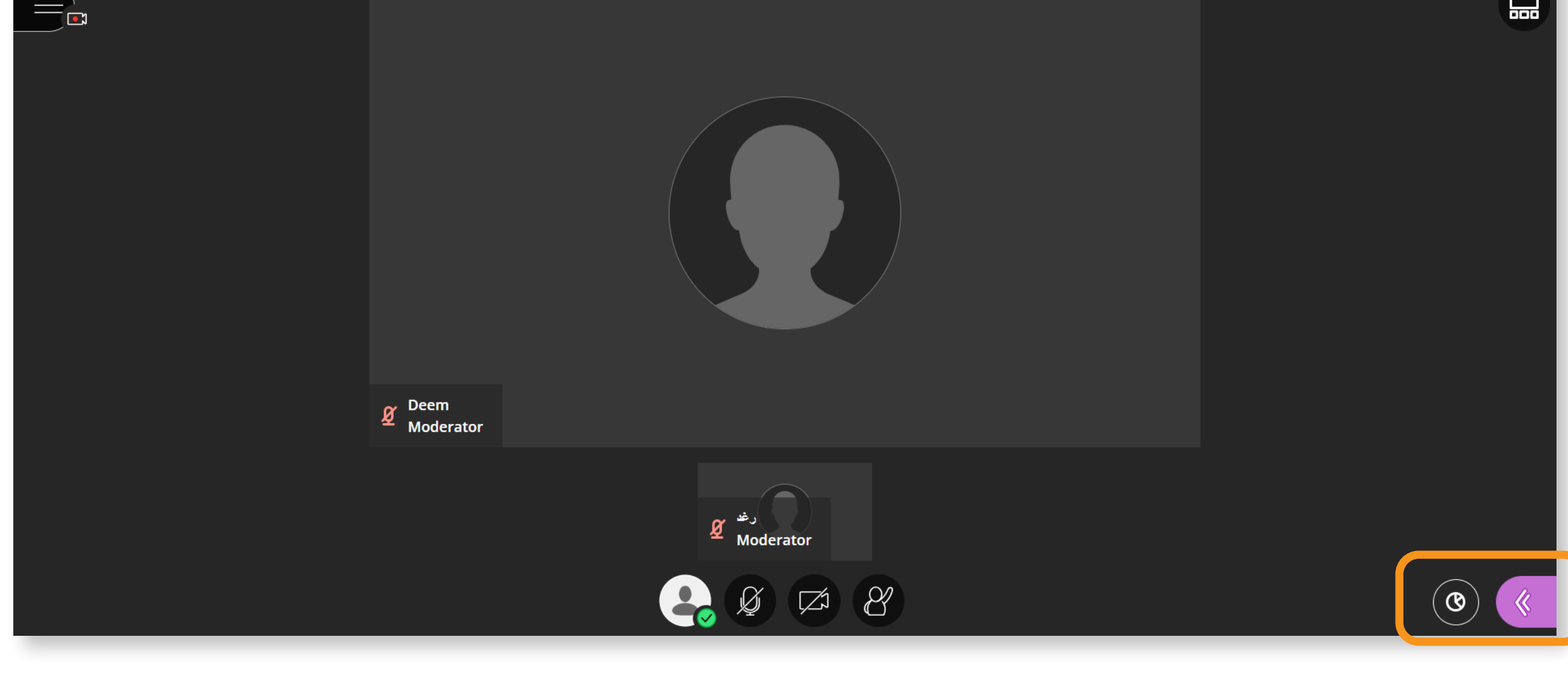


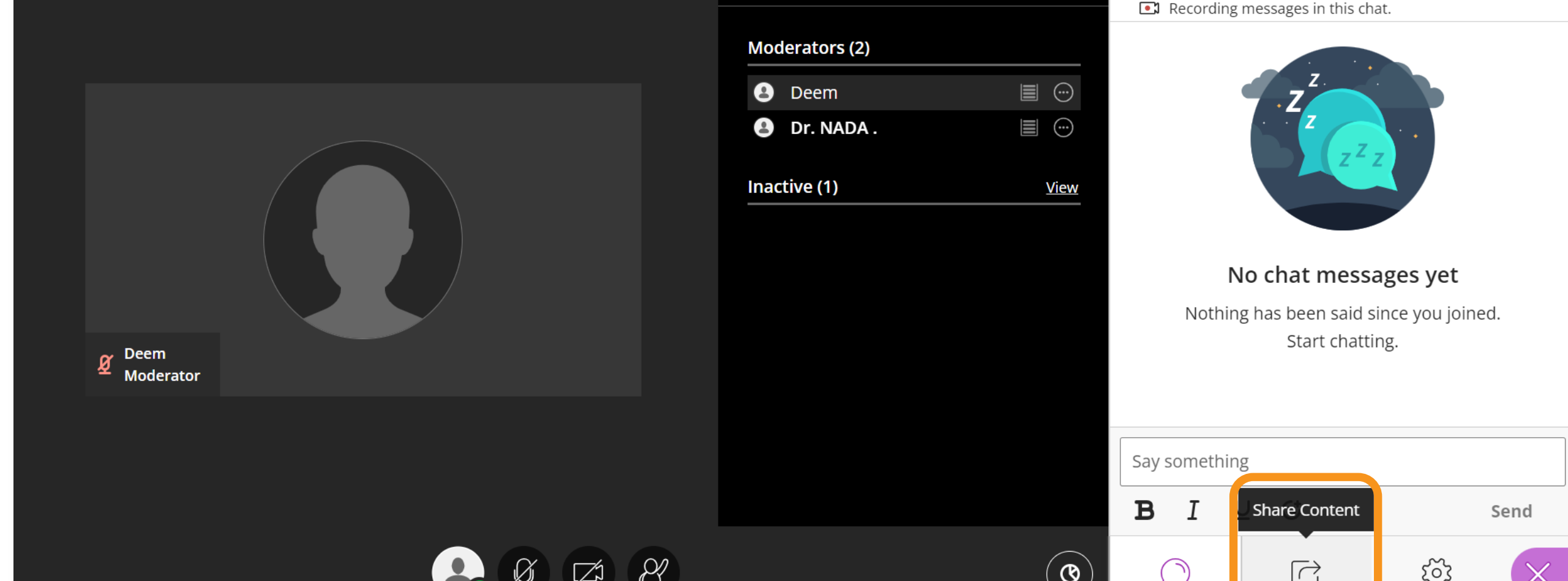
Organizing oral exams through virtual classes

The mechanism of dividing students into groups within the virtual classroom:

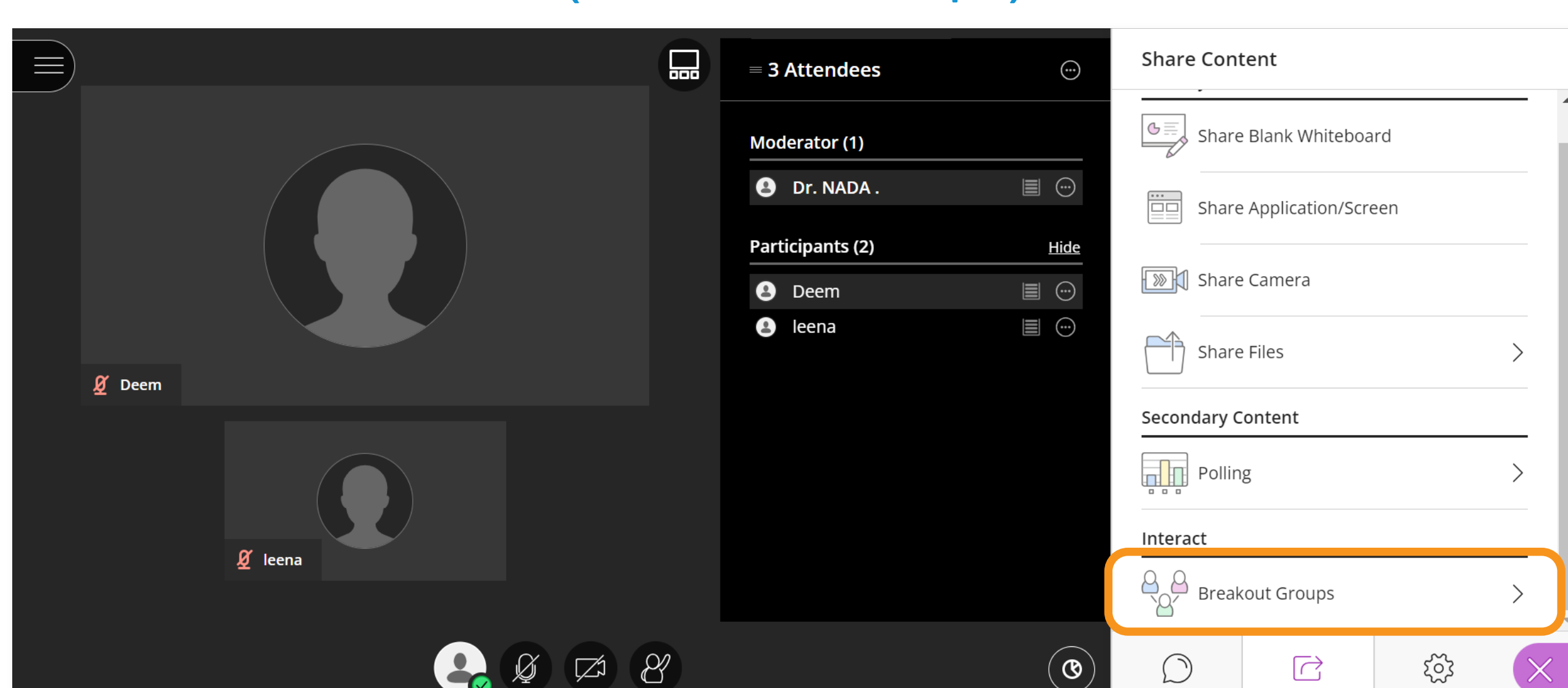
- 1 From the default chapter, click the Open (Collaborate panel) in the lower left of the screen.



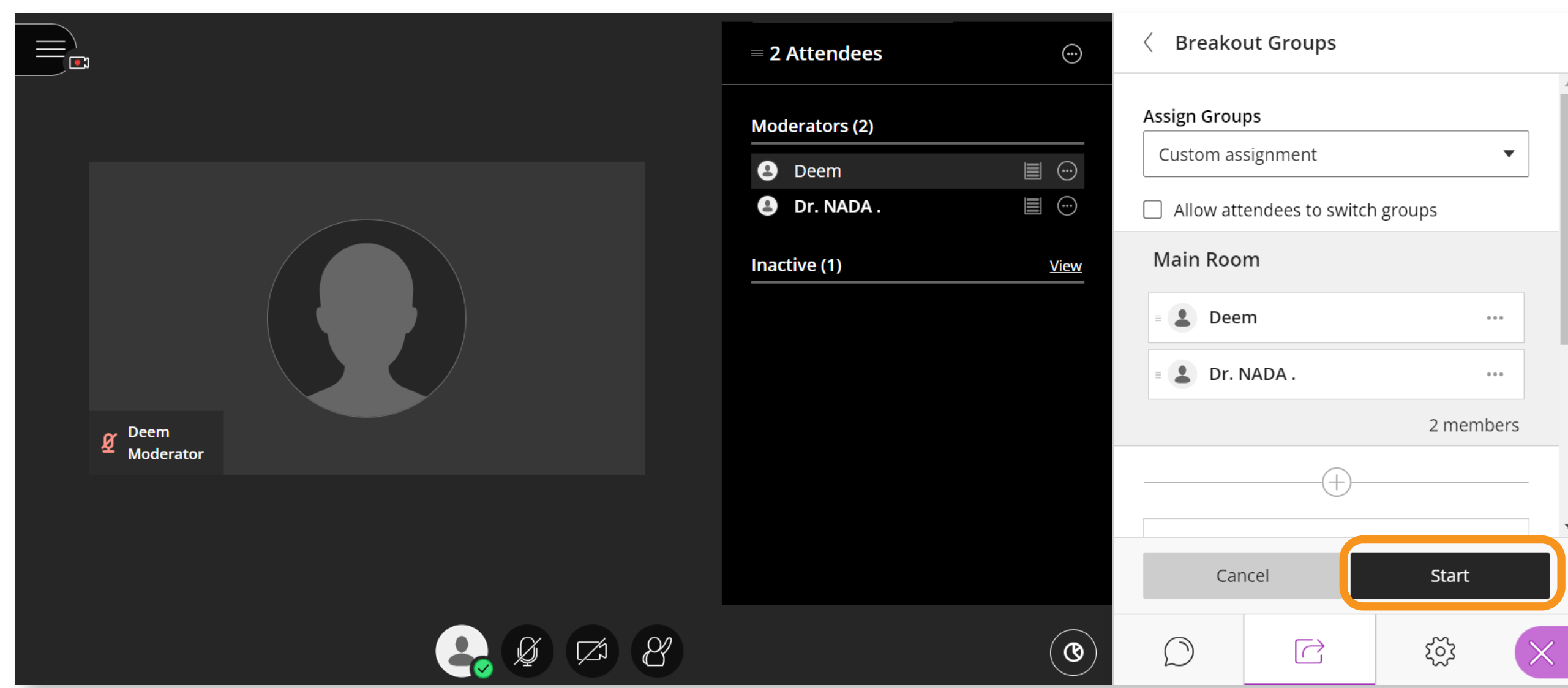
- 2 Click on the (Share Content) button.



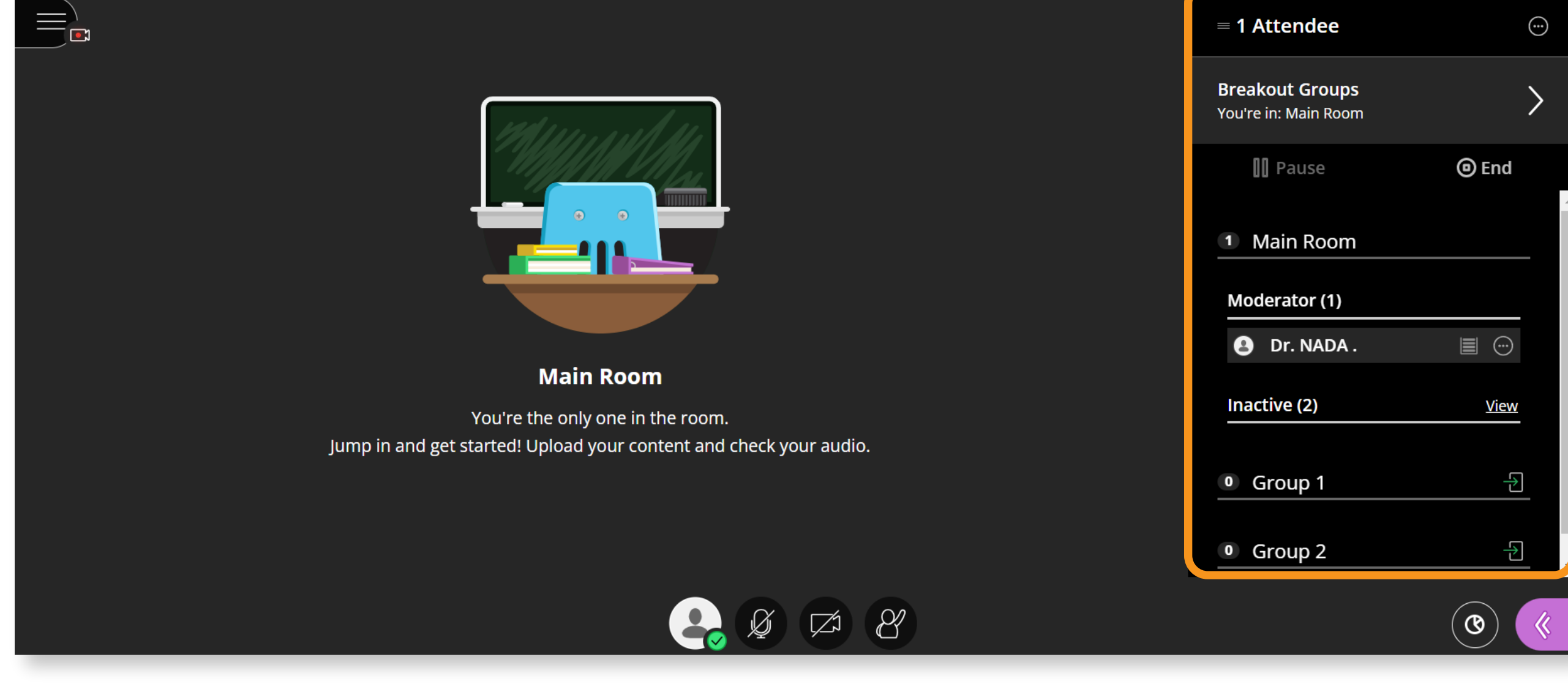
- 3 From the list, choose (Breakout Groups).



- 4 Select the number of groups you want and then click (Start).

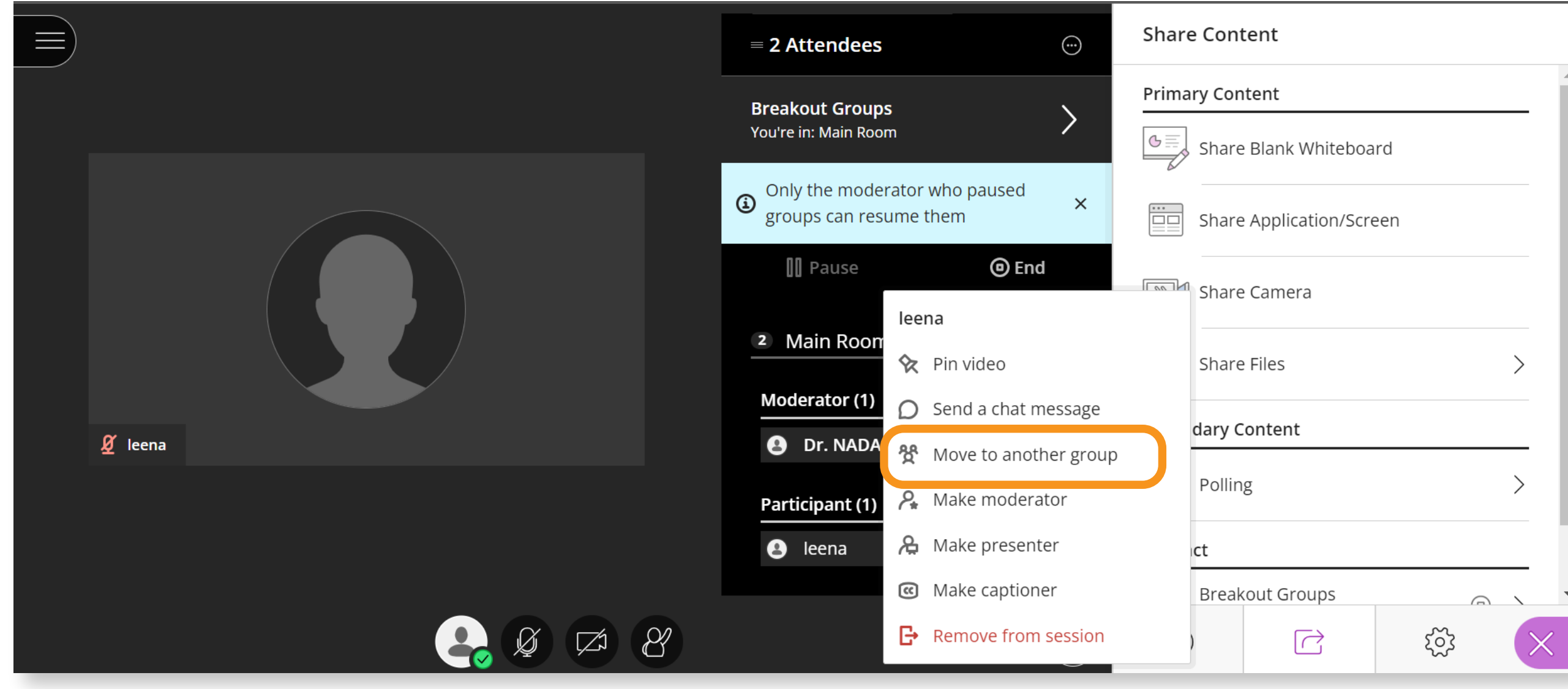


- 5 The view will change within the virtual classroom where students are randomly divided into two groups with the faculty member staying inside the main room so that students cannot hear it.

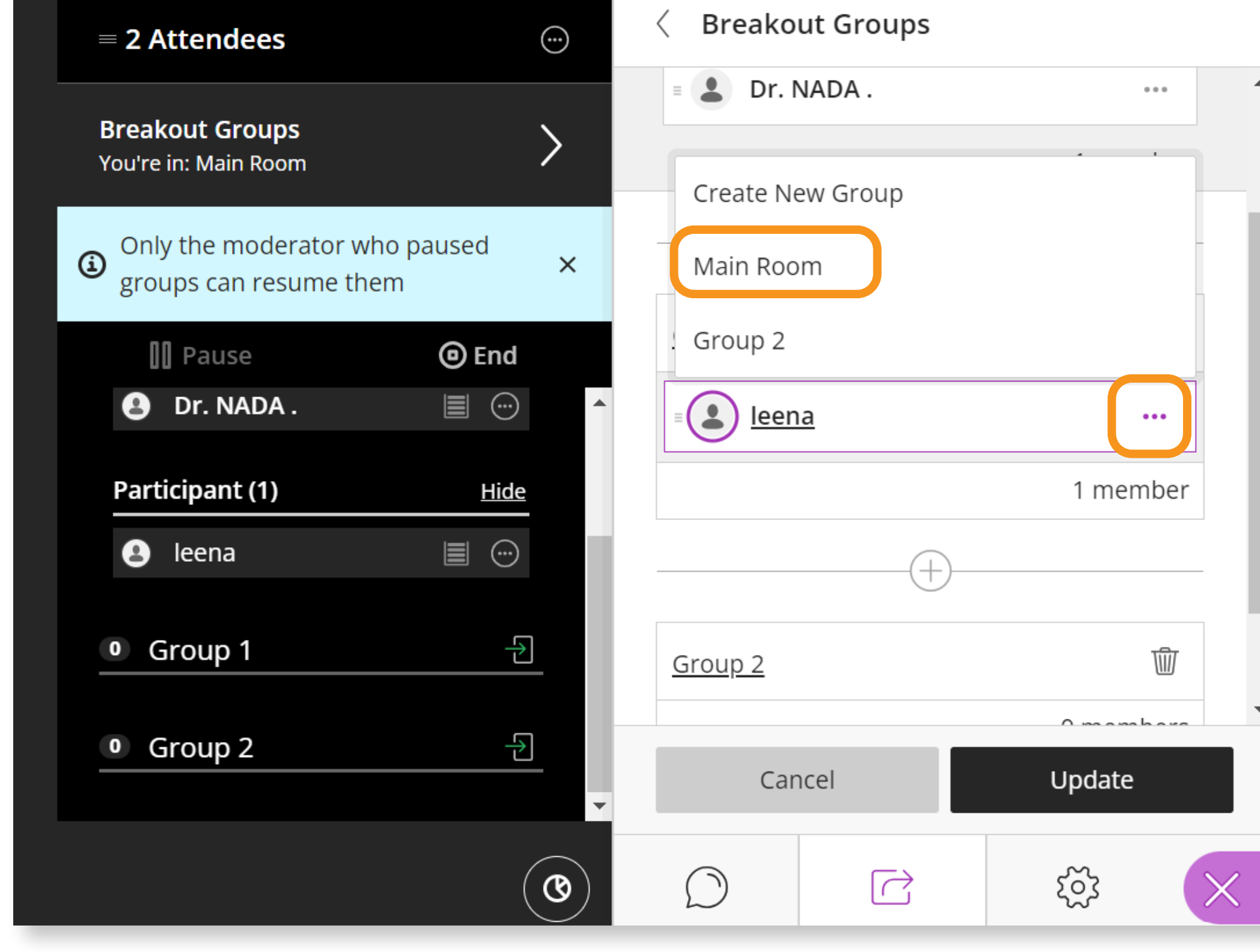


To begin the oral exam, move students one by one to the main room by following these steps:

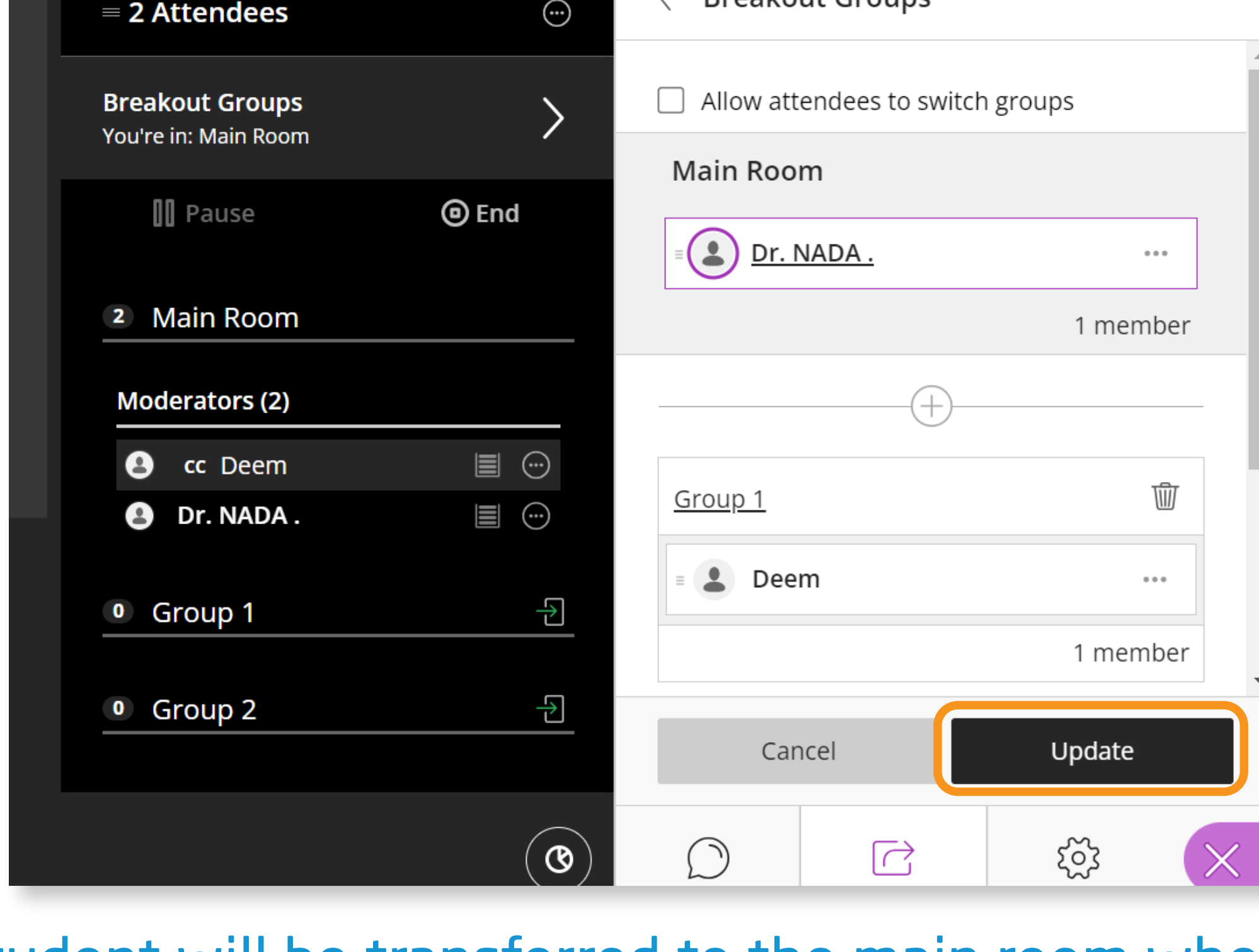
- 1 Click Participant Settings and then choose (Move to another group).



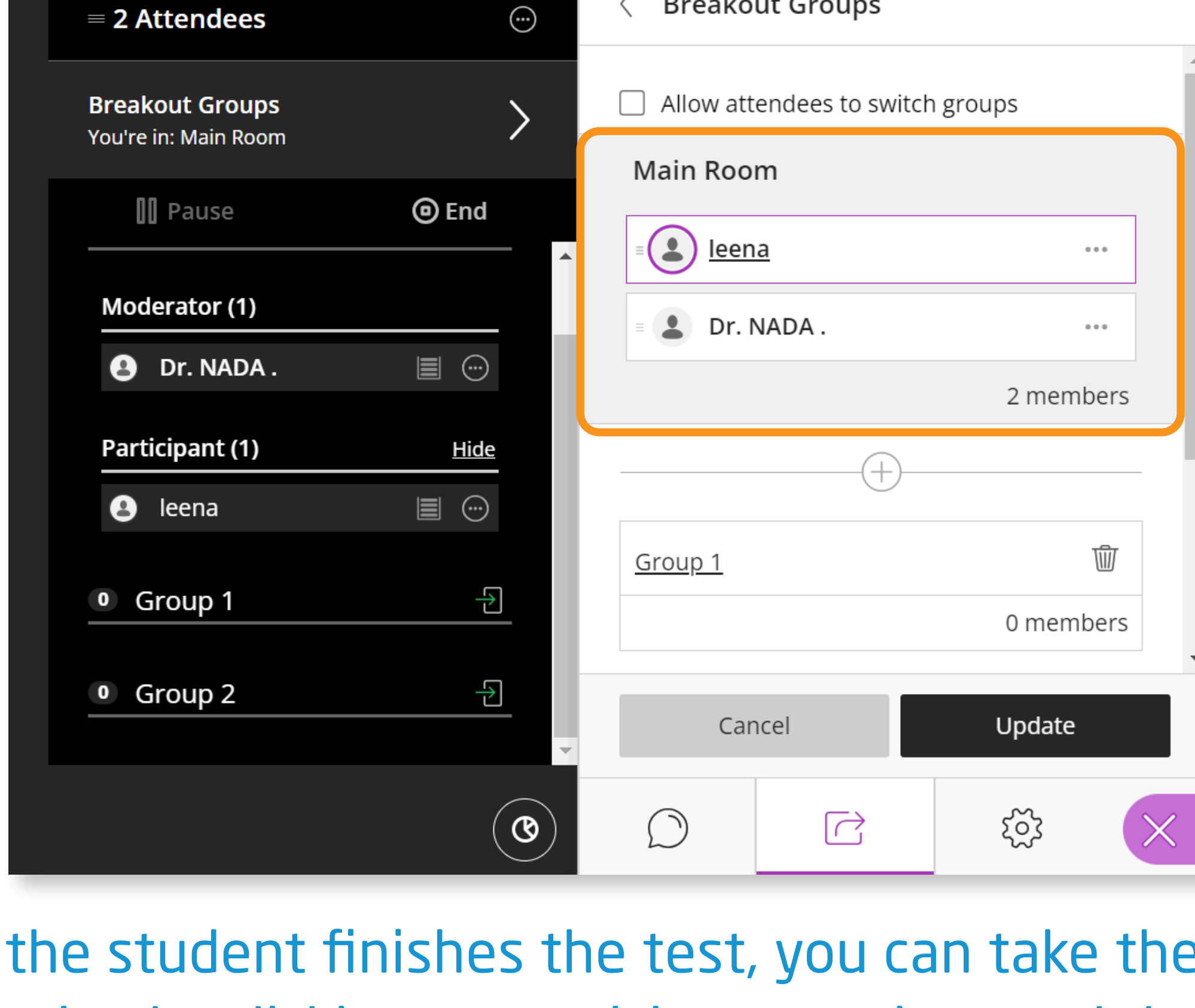
- 2 Click the options next to the student's name to be tested and then select (Main Room).



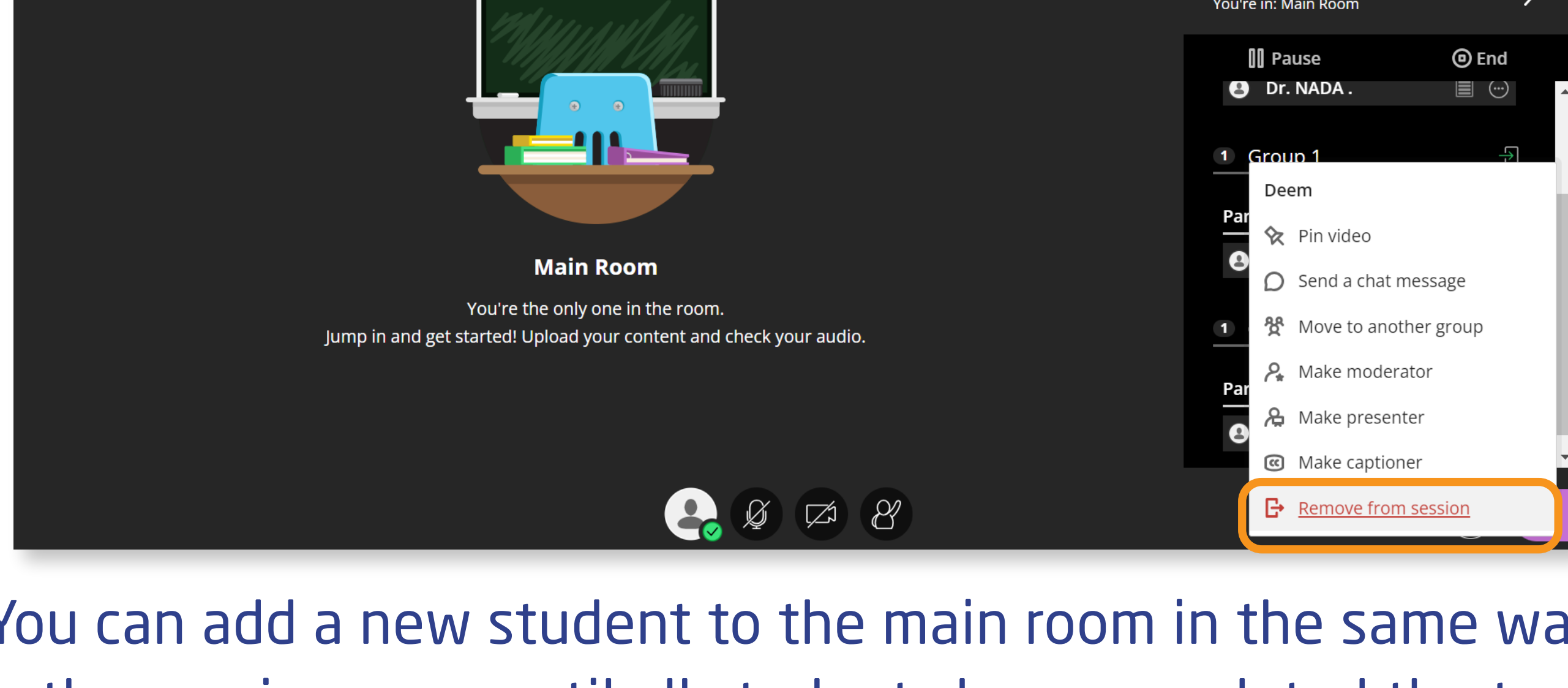
- 3 Then Click on (Update).



- 4 The student will be transferred to the main room where you can direct the student to turn on the microphone and start the test.



- 5 When the student finishes the test, you can take them out of the session by clicking on participant settings and then choose



You can add a new student to the main room in the same way as the previous one until all students have completed the test.
